### Principal's Report (Mrs. Hornung)

**1) School Updates:** Mrs. Hornung gave a brief behavioral data presentation on Loveland's Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program. Loveland's PBIS committee is made up of staff and parents. Data on major and minor behavioral incidents is collected, and the team meets weekly to discuss trends. The state coach will be visiting Loveland on 10-3-17. Historically, Loveland receives a good report from the state visit.
