Principal's Report, Stephanie Hornung

- 1) School Updates:
 - a. Reading Screenings will take place on January 11 for each class. These are done three times each school (fall, winter, and spring) year to gauge each student's progress with literacy.
 - b. Friday, January 12, report cards will come home in Friday folders, along with MAP testing results for grades 3-6.
 - c. Friday, January 12 is Adult Night Out at the Interlude Lounge.
 - d. There will be no school on January 15 in honor of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
 - e. Open gym night will be January 19, featuring Tae Kwan Do.
 - f. The fifth grade will take a field trip to the symphony on January 31.
 - g. The Lion King performances will be over the weekend of February 23. More details will follow in the weeks ahead regarding performance times.
- 2) Teacher Grants
 - a. Carla Lane, Guidance Counselor, was awarded \$50 for books on keeping one's hands to oneself.
 - b. The kindergarten and first grade teachers were awarded \$160 for alphabet cards that will be used in conjunction with their phonics instructional routines.
