Approval of meeting minutes from August 23rd.

Principals Report

“Rock Star” kick off for this year’s behavior incentive. Data is starting to come in for reading and math screenings.

Teacher Grants –

1. Mrs. Spady to take her Math 6 Honors Students to Skate Daze (arcade game coding, reaction times while skating/falling/ electrical currents and more) - \$117.
2. Special Education teachers for foldable teepees/sensory booths - \$60
3. Sixth Grade teachers for a paper cutter (\$60) and 3D splash accounts for their students to be able to download an app for the 3D printer (\$100 yearly).
4. Mrs. Gollehon - \$200 for paint in various colors

President’s Report – Joy Suder

1. Cub Scouts – The cub scouts are having issues with their charter at Loveland. It seems they thought they had one with Loveland, and thru some digging it appears they do not. This appears to be a district-wide issue, not just something we are experiencing. The district is now in communication directly with the Cub Scouts to figure out how to resolve the issue. They had a meeting on Friday, and it’s now something that is out of our (LCC’s) hands. This is being passed down from the District directly, and we will keep everyone posted as we get more information.
2. Establishing a Fundraising Committee – In 2015 we decided to establish Loveland Launch, and got rid of selling various items (and only kept a percentage of the profits) and having one main fundraiser. We have now established a committee to streamline the process for vetting any new items and ideas as they pop up and need to be considered. They will also handle asking local businesses for donations, so they do not get overrun with asks, and so we do not lose potential funding. Annette Shukry is the appointed Chair of the Fundraising Committee. Please contact her if you would like to be involved.
3. Proposal of New Executive Board Position – Financial Secretary
The CFO of the district suggested we add this position to the LCC (as of now we have a Treasure and a Co-Treasurer). We have already had some fishing /scamming via the internet this year (as we did last year) and any safety and best practices we can instill will only help protect the LCC.
